
July 4th: Independence Day

American alligators live in the wild in the southeastern United States. You're most likely to spot them in Florida and Louisiana, where they live in rivers, lakes, ponds and swamps.



Bluebirds are omnivores, which means they eat both plants and other animals. When a bluebird is scouting insects to eat, it will perch on a high spot to look for its food before swooping down and grab something to eat.



This barrel-shaped animals covered with natural armor is called an **Armadillo**. In fact, its name in Spanish means 'little armored one.' The armadillo's armor works well against most predators in the wild.



Black with a bright white belly and eye patches **orcas** are easily distinguishable from other aquatic animals. They live where the water is cold but can live anywhere from the polar regions right up to the equator.



The name **rattlesnake** is used because they have a special tail with several parts on the end that can make a rattle sound. They live in North and South America, especially, but not always, in dry areas.

Manatees are herbivores and eat over 60 different plants. They eat around 50kg of food a day and spend up to seven hours a day eating.

Manatees live in shallow, calm rivers, estuaries, bays, canals and coastal areas. Manatees can travel from fresh to salt water without any problems. The Florida manatee is found most of its time in Florida but can travel as far north as Virginia.
