


Step 1: Draw the snowflake



Using a pencil, draw the snowflake on the paper plate.
Ou can use a ruler to dray

You can use a ruler to draw straight lines.

You'll find patterns at the end of the booklet.






Step 2: Poke the holes



Use the push pin to poke holes at each end and each intersection of your snowflake.













Step 3: Start the snowflake



Thread the needle, tie a knot at the end and pull it through the center hole.



Step 4: Continue threading the snowflake



Use the holes you poked to thread throught the snowflake pattern.




Don't forget to poke a hole at the top of the plate to hang your snowflake.


