Let's get it started!

You need:

a dedicated
assistant

a push pin

a pencil

thread

a ruler



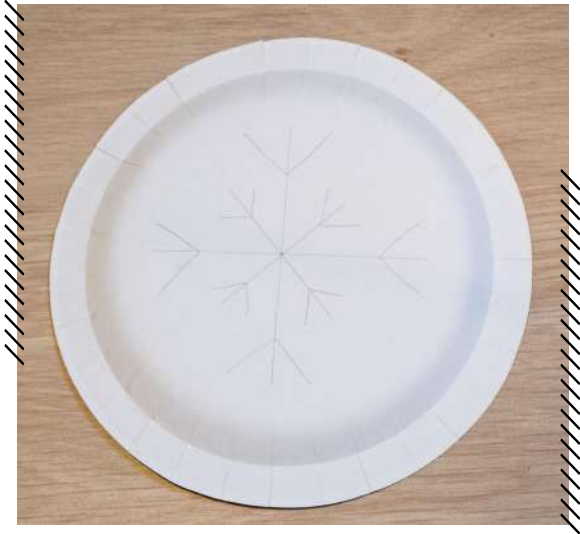
scissors

a needle (with
round point)

a paper plate



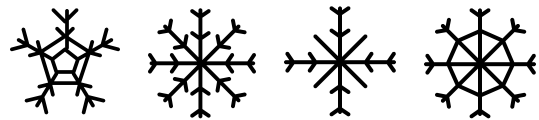
Step 1: Draw the snowflake



Using a pencil, draw the snowflake on the paper plate.

You can use a ruler to draw straight lines.

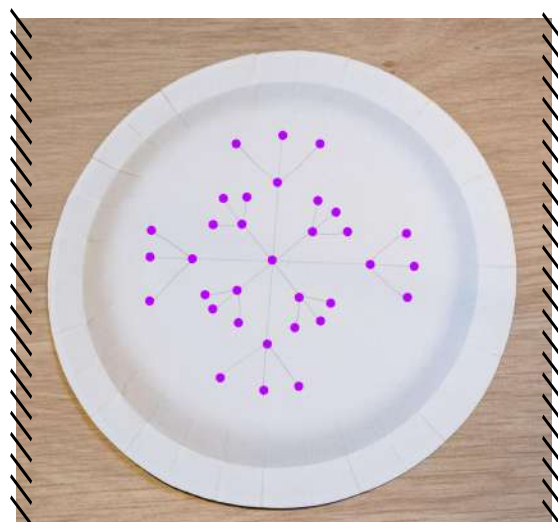
You'll find patterns at the end of the booklet.



Step 2: Poke the holes

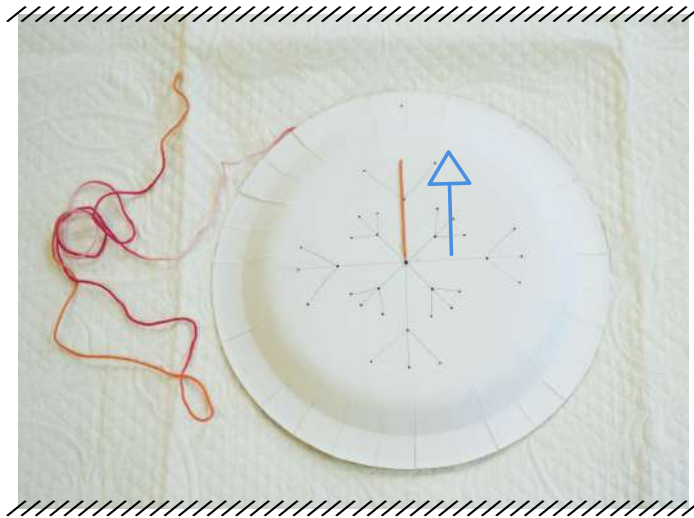


Use the push pin to poke holes at each end and each intersection of your snowflake.





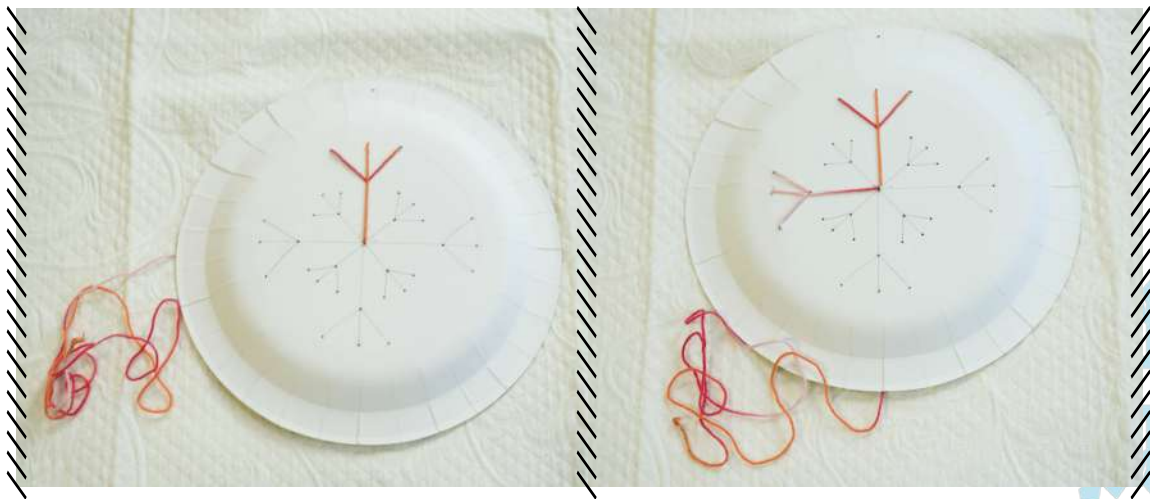
Step 3 : Start the snowflake



Thread the needle, tie a knot at the end and pull it through the center hole.



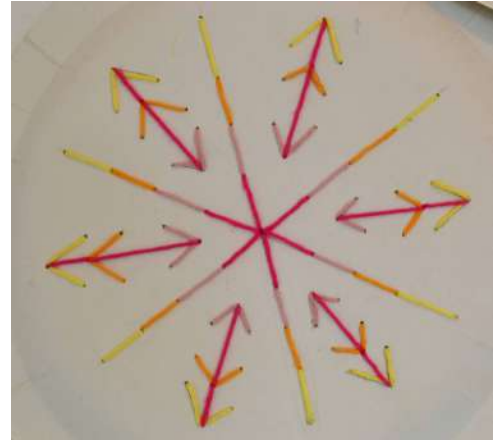
Step 4 : Continue threading the snowflake



Use the holes you poked to thread through the snowflake pattern.



There you go!

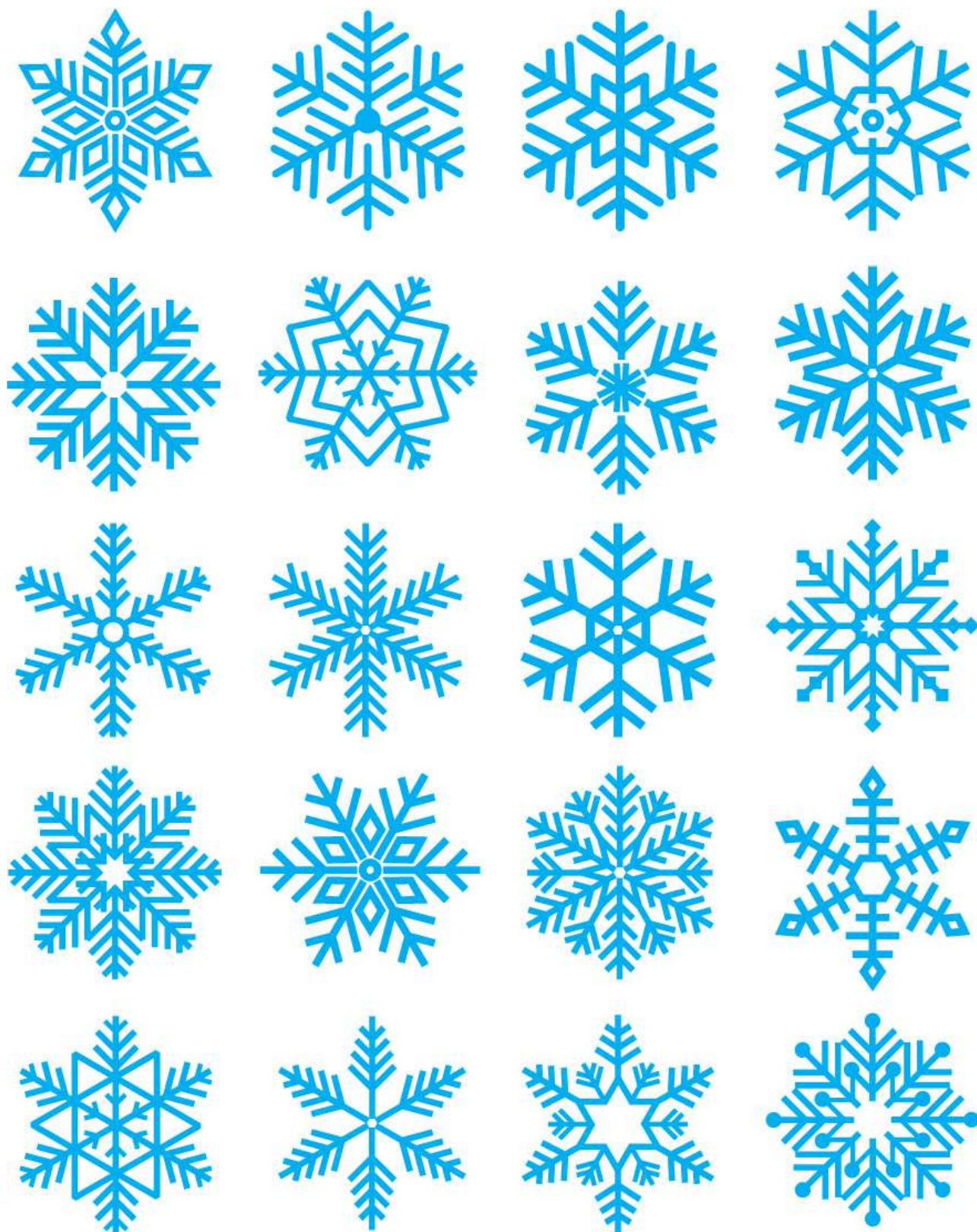


As you can see,

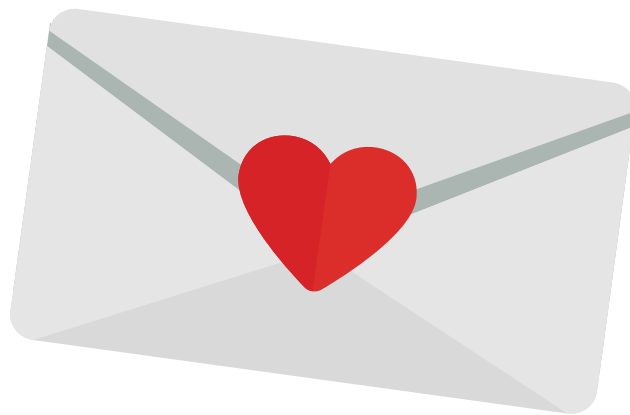
